Late Work	 Late work will only be accepted under the following conditions: Excused Absence (Parents must notify the school of the student's absence by 9:30 a.m. on the day of the absence.) Family Emergency (Parents must notify school.) Suspension from School (If students are suspended three or more days, then parents must request assignments.) Absent students need to refer to MiStar, Google Classroom, or Google Sites for daily assignments. All assignments due upon return.
Academic Planners	 It is strongly suggested that each student provide his/her own academic planner. The academic planner is used daily to record the agenda from the board the first/last five minutes of each class. When planners are taken home EACH DAY, both student and parent may view and discuss the day's activities and homework.
Lockers & Locks	 Students will be assigned individual lockers. Students will have access to locker throughout the day and are expected to arrive to classes on time. Lock combinations must be numbers. Keys for locks are not permitted.
Arrival	 After the 8:45 a.m. bell, students will go to their lockers and then to their first hour House Advisory classroom. All students must put away their backpacks and grab materials needed for classes.
Dismissal	 At 3:50 p.m., students will go to their lockers and gather materials to take home. Students will report to their House Advisory teachers. During hall passing time, students are expected to walk to the right in the
Hall Passing Dress Code,	 During hall passing time, students are expected to walk to the right in the hallway and use the stairwell by the elevator. Students will adhere to the District's dress code.
Purses, Backpacks, Etc.	 Female students are not permitted to carry purses to class. When needed, they will be allowed to go to their lockers for personal items. Students are not allowed to carry backpacks or string bags. Rolling backpacks/carts are not allowed at MacArthur, since they do not fit in the lockers. Backpacks/carts will not be stored in classrooms. Hooded items are not permitted and must be stored in lockers. Shirts will be tucked. Numbered combination locks only (No letters, symbols or key locks).
