Late Work	<ul> <li>Late work will only be accepted under the following conditions:</li> <li>Excused Absence (Parents must notify the school of the student's absence by 9:30 a.m. on the day of the absence.)</li> <li>Family Emergency (Parents must notify school.)</li> <li>Suspension from School (If students are suspended three or more days, then parents must request assignments.)</li> <li>Absent students need to refer to MiStar, Google Classroom, or Google Sites for daily assignments.</li> <li>All assignments due upon return.</li> </ul>
Academic Planners	<ul> <li>It is strongly suggested that each student provide his/her own academic planner.</li> <li>The academic planner is used daily to record the agenda from the board the first/last five minutes of each class.</li> <li>When planners are taken home EACH DAY, both student and parent may view and discuss the day's activities and homework.</li> </ul>
Lockers & Locks	<ul> <li>Students will be assigned individual lockers.</li> <li>Students will have access to locker throughout the day and are expected to arrive to classes on time.</li> <li>Lock combinations must be numbers.</li> <li>Keys for locks are not permitted.</li> </ul>
Arrival	<ul> <li>After the 8:45 a.m. bell, students will go to their lockers and then to their first hour House Advisory classroom.</li> <li>All students must put away their backpacks and grab materials needed for classes.</li> </ul>
Dismissal	<ul> <li>At 3:50 p.m., students will go to their lockers and gather materials to take home.</li> <li>Students will report to their House Advisory teachers.</li> <li>During hall passing time, students are expected to walk to the right in the</li> </ul>
Hall Passing Dress Code,	<ul> <li>During hall passing time, students are expected to walk to the right in the hallway and use the stairwell by the elevator.</li> <li>Students will adhere to the District's dress code.</li> </ul>
Purses, Backpacks, Etc.	<ul> <li>Female students are not permitted to carry purses to class. When needed, they will be allowed to go to their lockers for personal items.</li> <li>Students are not allowed to carry backpacks or string bags.</li> <li>Rolling backpacks/carts are not allowed at MacArthur, since they do not fit in the lockers.</li> <li>Backpacks/carts will not be stored in classrooms.</li> <li>Hooded items are not permitted and must be stored in lockers.</li> <li>Shirts will be tucked.</li> <li>Numbered combination locks only (No letters, symbols or key locks).</li> </ul>
