Selection of Members Southfield High for the Arts and Technology National Honor Society

- 1. To be eligible for membership, the candidate must be in grade 10th thru 12th sophomore, junior or senior as designated by the credits obtained toward graduation. Candidates must have been in attendance at Southfield High for The Arts and Technology prior to application submission.- (Students who transfer into Southfield High for The Arts and Technology who were former members are eligible for admittance pending verification of grades and status.
- 2. Candidates must have a cumulative unweighted, unmodified scholastic GPA based on NASSP guidelines. Candidates shall then be evaluated on the basis of service, leadership, and character. The candidate must have the prerequisite grade point average and complete the Southfield High for The Arts and Technology National Honor Society Application by the posted deadline.
- 3. If a student has received academic misconduct, they are not eligible to apply for 365 days from the academic misconduct.
- 4. A description of the application process will appear on the Southfield High for the Arts and Technology website as National Honor Society. Selected members will receive an invitation to the induction via email. The selection procedure shall be determined by the Faculty Council and shall be consistent with the rules and regulations of the National Honor Society.
- 5. Membership induction shall occur, after first card marking of each school year, unless no qualified candidates emerge during the selection process. Active members are expected to attend the National Honor Society Induction Ceremonies.
