Welcome to the home of the Tigers! This year your child continues to have the privilege of attending an International Baccalaureate World School, under the leadership of Mrs. Lightsey and Mr. Czapski our new Assistant Principal. Mr. Czapski, comes to us from Southfield Lathrup High School. He has serviced Southfield Public School for over fifteen years. Along with our dynamic team of faculty members, we are excited to continue ensuring that our students can achieve their highest potential.

The **first day** of school for students is **September 6, 2016**. Students should not arrive to school before 8:20 A.M. The **first bell** will ring at **8:40 A.M.**, and the tardy/late bell will ring at 8:45 A.M. **Dismissal** is at **4:00 P.M.**; we will not honor early pick-ups after 3:30 P.M. On the first day of school, all K-5 students will assemble in the cafeteria, and all 6th-8th grade students will assemble in the gym. Teachers will then escort students to class. Documents will also be sent to your email account by way of School Messenger. **PYP (Kindergarten -5<sup>th</sup> grade) class assignments will be posted on the main entrance door and the café entrance door by Friday, September 2, 2016. MYP (6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade) will receive their schedule and locker assignment on the September 6<sup>th</sup>. Opening Packets will be sent home on the first day of school.**
