

Primary Years Program (PYP) SUPPLIES REQUEST LIST

3RD GRADE:

- A large, strong school bag (no wheels)...clearly labeled with your full name
- A supply of No. 2 pencils (Ticonderoga are the BEST!)
- Pencil top erasers
- Red pens for checking
- Post-It notes with lines (1 pack)
- Two reams of copy paper
- 5 (different colors or patterns) composition notebooks (labeled Do Now, Writers Notebook, Math, Science/Social Studies, English/ Reading)
- 1 folder with pockets (Plastic ones work best!)
- One pair of scissors
- One ruler that displays inches and centimeters
- 1 large bottle of hand sanitizer
- 2 boxes of tissue
- 1 container of disinfecting wipes
- 1 large cloth pencil pouch (not the plastic box)
- Crayons and colored pencils to be stored in a pencil pouch
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 package of dry erase markers (large)
- 1 gallon zip-lock pages
- Ear buds/headphones (state test, spelling test & multiplication timing test)

4th GRADE:

These items are for personal use and will be stored by the student in their pencil case and/or their locker:
