#### **RETURN TO SCHOOL UPDATES**

We have established a web page where you can find information on our school reopening plans. Information for the Hybrid (half-day in-person) plan was sent to all K-5 families last week. After reviewing the data, we have noticed that half of our families did not indicate their choice in MiStar, which resulted in a high number of default full virtual learning choices. Please follow the directions below to indicate the official learning choice for your child no later than **3:00pm on Wednesday**, **February 24th**.

# **Enrollment Choice for Phase II Hybrid/Virtual Learning Options**

K-2 families will have the option to return to learn in a hybrid model beginning March 15, 2021. Grades 3-5 will have the option to return to learn in a hybrid model beginning March 22,



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2021. When and if other groups of students are given the option to return to in-person instruction, families will be notified of that process.

By choosing Hybrid, you agree that your child will:

- 1. Bring their district-provided Chromebook to school on Face-to-Face days if they were assigned one.
- 2. Follow mask-wearing guidelines.
- 3. Follow all other safety guidelines as deemed necessary by the district.

Your choices are as follows:

- **Choice A** (Hybrid Learning) A mix of face-to-face and virtual instruction. The number of face-to-face days offered will be determined by staff and family data.
- Choice B (Full Virtual Learning) All instruction will remain virtual.
- **Choice C** (District Choice) Families who have the flexibility to allow the district to make the choice of hybrid or virtual based upon capacity.

# DIRECTIONS FOR UPDATING CONTACT INFORMATION AND MAKING YOUR RETURN TO LEARN SELECTION

- Log into your MiStar/Parent Connect Account. If you forget your password, click on the Need Your Login Information? link. Follow the instructions and your password will be sent to the email address on file. If you do not have an email address on file, you will need to contact your child's school.
- 2. Upon logging into Parent Portal, click My Account
- 3. Click edit next to the contact field. Ensure that the fields are accurate and update those as necessary.
- 4. Proceed to the **My Information** section in MiStar/Parent Connect.
- 5. Click **Edit** next to your student(s) name to select the learning choice.
- \*Failure to select a learning choice <u>before 3:00pm on Wednesday, February 24th</u> will result in the student remaining virtual.

\*For all options, the student's assigned teachers are subject to change based upon enrollment results and district staffing needs.

In order to implement the next phase of the district's Return to Learn Plan with fidelity, accurate data is necessary. If you need assistance with your MiStar login, our school secretary will be able to assist you at 248.746.7401 or 248.746.7402.



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Additionally, this official MiStar learning choice process supersedes any previous general survey data. Please note that if no choice is made by the deadline, the default choice for your child will be full virtual. See below for the phased in plan as it relates to Thompson K-8 students:

- April 5: TENTATIVE return date for students in grades 6-8.
